







# Racism has an Outsized Impact in New Mexico

Child population (ages 0-19) by race/ethnicity (2017)










# **Policy Solutions**

- Banned solitary confinement for youth
- Enacted "ban the box" legislation
- Increased the College Affordability Fund awards
- Enabled the creation of dental therapists
- Raised the state minimum wage
- Increased the Working Families Tax Credit
- Creation of the early education department
